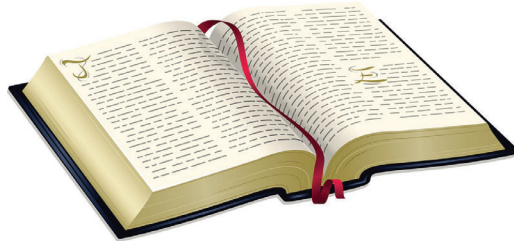

An Introduction to New Life in Jesus

Read each verse listed and answer the questions that follow.

Part 1 Who is Jesus Christ?

(John 6:67-69) Who was Jesus according to Peter in verse 69? the Son of the living God

(John 1:29) What was Jesus called? Lamb of God

(John 14:6) What three things does Christ call himself?

(1) I am the Way (2) the Truth (3) the Life

(John 10:33) Who did the people listening to Jesus say he claimed to be? God

(John 15:13) Why did Jesus Christ lay down his life for us? Because of His great love for us

(John 11:25) What two things did Jesus say about himself? I am the Resurrection & Life

(John 20:25 and 20:29) The disciples were eyewitnesses that Christ was now alive. What did Jesus say about those who have not seen and yet believe? They are blessed

Part 2 Our Problem: Sin - God's Solution: Jesus

(Romans 3:10-11) Give three ways that mankind is described.

(1) no one is righteous

(2) no one understands

(3) no one seeks God

(Romans 3:23) What does God say about everyone?

All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

(Romans 5:8) What way did God provide for us to be saved? By Christ dying for us

(Romans 5:10) We were God's enemies but we may be reconciled to God.

How is this accomplished?

Through the death of the Son of God

Note: *Reconciliation* describes the purpose of Christ's death on the cross. The natural man is opposed to God, and separated from him. Christ's death on the cross was the supreme sacrifice. It reconciled us to God, making us acceptable to him.

(Romans 6:23) What are the wages of sin? Death What is the gift of God? Eternal life

Through whom does this gift come? Through Christ Jesus our Lord

(1 Timothy 1:15) What is the faithful saying in this verse?

Christ came into the world to save sinners

(1 Corinthians 15:3-4) These verses give us the basic truths of the gospel that Paul preached. Write out these verses using your own words.

Christ died for our sins, was buried and rose on the third day.

(Revelation 20:15) What is the final judgment of those who reject Christ?

cast into the lake of fire

Part 3 Assurance that we are His Children

(Romans 8:35-39) What can separate us from Christ's love? NOTHING!

(John 1:12) Those who receive Christ are given the power (right) to become...

Children of God

(Galatians 4:6) What has God done because we are sons? _____

Sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts

(Romans 8:16) The Spirit bears witness with our spirit that we are God's children

(1 Corinthians 6:11) What three things has God done for the Christians?

(1) Washed (2) Sanctified (3) Justified

(Romans 8:1) What does this verse say about those that are in Christ Jesus?

There is now no condemnation for them

(John 5:24) The believer shall not come into condemnation,

but is passed from death into life

Part 4 Our New Life in Christ

Two important facts that every Christian must know are:

(1) Since he is born of the Spirit, he now has a new nature and

(2) This new nature is in conflict with the old nature, often referred to as “the flesh.”

(Romans 7:18) What did Paul say about the flesh?

Nothing good lives (dwelleth) in it.

(Romans 8:7) What two things are said about the carnal (fleshly) mind?

(1) It is hostile to God. (2) It doesn't submit to God's law.

(2 Corinthians 5:17) The new nature is sometimes referred to as “a new creation.”

What is the result of being a new creation (creature) in Christ?

old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.

(Galatians 2:20) The new man is Christ living in the believer. As Paul said, “...Christ lives in me.”

(1 John 4:4) This enables us to overcome the old nature because “. . .

the One who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world

(Romans 12:2) It is God’s desire that we not be conformed to this evil world,
but that we should be ...

transformed by the renewing of our minds

(Titus 2:11-12) What does verse 12 teach us concerning how we should live?

To live self-controlled, and upright and godly lives in this present age.

(Galatians 5:19-23) This passage contrasts the work of the flesh with the work of the Holy Spirit in us. List nine things that are the fruit of the Spirit (verses 22-23):

- (1) love (2) joy (3) peace
(4) longsuffering (5) gentleness (6) goodness
(7) faith (8) meekness (9) temperance (self-control)
